

LENTEN SEASON OPPORTUNITIES

Our Lenten journey to Easter begins on February 18 with Ash Wednesday. The observance of Lent began as a part of the preparation new believers received for their baptism on Easter day. Our modern observance of Lent has evolved as a time of spiritual reflection and repentance in the truest form – a turning away from what separates us from God and a turning towards the new life we have in Christ.



Ash Wednesday is the first day of the Season of Lent. Please plan to attend a special worship service Wednesday evening, February 18 at 7:00 p.m. The service is designed to offer a meaningful beginning to this season when many Christians pay extra attention to their practices of Christian faith, in order to prepare for a meaningful Easter celebration.

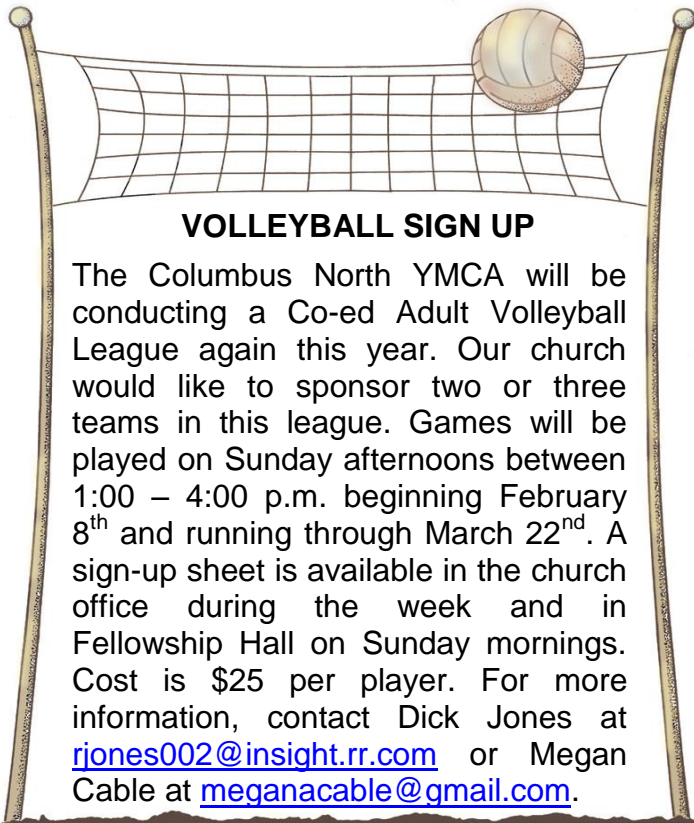
