This past fall, we asked you to recognize WPC's "Generations of Generosity" and prayerfully consider increasing your giving so our church could sustain our pastoral staff and robust programs. 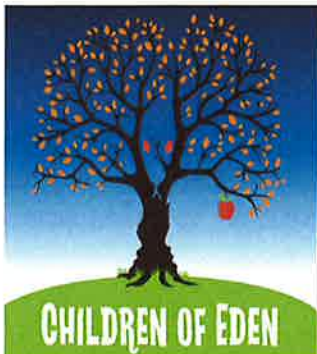
